Wagering

Requirements

In most

cases there will be wagering requirements attached to

your bonus.

This is amount you need to wager before any winnings can be

withdrawn as real cash, and

there will usually be a specific time frame in which you must meet

these

requirements.

For example, if you win \$5 from your free cash at a casino with 40

x

wagering, you would need to wager \$200 (\$5 x 40)

within the specified time frame before

withdrawing the winnings as cash.

Depending on the time frame which can vary vastly

between casinos you might not achieve this, and wouldn't be able to c

laim your

winnings. Check the terms and conditions of any bonus before

you sign up to avoid any

surprises later on.

Time-Sensitive Bonuses

Time restrictions won't only apply to

wagering requirements- you'll usually have a limited time in which you

can use your

free spins or free cash. You'll find all information about

these limits in the terms

and conditions of your chosen no deposit bonus.
