

## cbet meaning in rtu

If anyone remembers me from a couple months ago I was beating 10NL for 5BB/100 and losing at 25NL for 10BB/100. I took a 3 month break from online poker, completely changed my game, and now am beating it at 5BB/100 for like 20k hands. I'm a few buyins above EV but even accounting for that I'm pretty confident I can actually beat this level now.  
I went from a 30/25/10 LAG to just ABC TAG. I don't bluff, hardly ever cbet unless it's for value or I have a monster draw, and play incredibly predictably. I would get eaten alive by thinking players, but it took me 6 months to realize that the players at 25NL don't think. I limp low pps from EP to setmine and get paid off 100% if villains hit top pair, I imp/rr AA UTG in FR games and they still stack off with QQ or AK, I donk then triple barrel monsters and still get paid off by TPGK, I have a 5% 3betting range from the blinds but people think I'm always 3betting light and stack off with 99+ in BVB or blind vs BTN. I really do play 25NL like I play live 1/2 and it's working because dumb ass regs keep leveling themselves into thinking I'm bluffing them all the time.  
I used to be just like them TBH. I used to get into these 3bet/4bet shoving wars preflop and double float people with air to take it down on the river and triple barrel A high and make other horribly spewy plays because I thought I needed to play like durrrr to beat 25NL. Turns out you don't need to be afraid of the villains at 25NL; they're all morons who read a post about 3betting and now think they have to 3bet KQ from the BTN everytime, but they missed the article about polarizing your 3betting range against TAGs and nits. Just play ABC poker and you'll crush them.
