&lt;p&gt;It &#127877; was formed in 2008 after the merge between the G-14 and t

he European Club Forum,[1] which comprised a small number &#127877; of elite cl

ubs and was unrecognised by UEFA.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;The ECA&#39;s mission statement is &quot;to create a new, more democrat

ic governance model &#127877; that truly reflects the key role of the clubs&quo

&lt;p&gt;After the 2022 Russian invasion of Ukraine, the ECA suspended its seven

ask force created by &#127877; UEFA in 2002 that reuned 102 member clubs,[1] in

January 2008, as from the 2017 19 membership cycle, the European Club &#127877;

Association represented 232 clubs, made up of 109 Ordinary Members and 123 Ass

ociated Members, with at least one from each &#127877; of the 54 national assoc

&lt;p&gt;The precise number of Ordinary Member clubs from each member associatio

n will be established every two &#127877; years at the end of the UEFA season o

n the basis of the UEFA ranking of its member associations according &#127877;

ECA on &#127877; 15 February 2008, the new ECA also replaces UEFA&#39;s Europe

&lt;p&gt;[10] The &#127877; European Club Forum utilized a similar membership s

election process as the European Club Association, with 102 members picked every

&lt;p&gt;In April 2021 following the announcement of the European Super League,

several of the clubs involved resigned from the ECA.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;The &#127877; ECA had criticised the formation of the new league.&lt;/p&gt;
